The Baxter Health Employee Fund Drive (EFD) was created to fund certain areas that were not being supported in any other way, like the **Employee Crisis Fund** (to assist employees with a one time crisis) to the **Friends Fund** (prescription assistance for patients being discharged). A hospital **Department Needs Fund** was also added to serve departments with a sudden need for something not budgeted, followed by the **Employee Children & Grandchildren Scholarship Fund**. Each of these have been and continue to be funded solely by the Employee Fund Drive!

Since then, the EFD Committee listened to their fellow employees regarding what they felt was important to support and added the **Mountain Home Christian Clinic**, all three of the **Community Health Education and Support Houses**, and **Hospice of the Ozarks Hospice House**.
